- Members, juniors, guests and visitors of Corrstown Golf Club are requested to observe the Club's Dress Code on the course and in the clubhouse at all times.
- Copies of the Code are displayed at various locations throughout the Clubhouse.*
- The Committee's decision as to what constitutes acceptable dress is final.
- Smart, clean and neat casual dress is essential in the Clubhouse and on the Course.

- Corrstown Golf Club adhere to the highest standards of etiquette and asks all members and visitors to show due consideration to fellow golfers.
- Mobile phones should be on silent and on the golf course only used in emergencies.
- As a general rule, calls should not be taken / made in the bar / restaurant area.
- If you are using a mobile please do so discreetly and in a manner that shows proper consideration for others.
- All notices and signs must be obeyed.
- Members **MUST** register their guests in the visitors' book immediately upon arrival.
- Course staff has priority over players on the course while carrying out their duties and normal courtesy and co-operation should apply at all times.
- Bags, shoes and other equipment are not to be brought into or left in the entrance hall, passageways, bar/lounge or restaurant.
- Parents or guardians must supervise children less than 11 years of age at all times. This responsibility must be taken seriously given the dangers that exist in and around a building of this nature.
- Children must vacate the premises by the governed hour.
- Children only allowed on the balcony in the company of a supervising adult.
- Balcony stairs are for emergency use only.
